San Francisco, CA – The Executive Board of the Bay Area Law Enforcement Assistance Fund (BALEAF) announced its annual BALEAF Scholarship Program for 2021. BALEAF will be awarding five **Marilyn Rosekind Memorial Scholarships** in June. The 2021 scholarships honor BALEAF co-founder Marilyn Rosekind who passed in January 2021.

To be eligible, an applicant must be a dependent spouse, child, adopted child or step child of a sworn or non-sworn Law Enforcement Agency employee (active, retired or deceased) within the nine Bay Area Counties (San Francisco, San Mateo, Marin, Santa Clara, Alameda, Napa, Solano, Sonoma, Contra Costa). Applicants must be enrolled in the fall semester of the upcoming school year, be a full-time student carrying a minimum of 12 units per semester (or 6 units per quarter), and maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.0 or higher.

The deadline for receipt of applications for the 2021 BALEAF Scholarship is May 16, 2021. BALEAF will announce the 2021 Scholarship Recipients in June 2021. Additional details are on the website at BALEAF.org.
